





- 1. Each plot specifically provided for the burial of cremated remains is identified by the number and section reference.
- 2. Each plot size is 900mm x 900mm and may contain only 2 caskets.
- 3. All cremated remains must be placed in a biodegradable casket bearing the name of the deceased.
- 4. Cremated remains may not be scattered in this area.
- 5. The Council will provide all bases on which approved memorials may be placed at the expense of the person placing the order for the memorial.
- 6. No memorial may be placed without authorised approval.
- 7. All memorials shall be of natural stone and conform as follows:
 - Width: 300mm
 - Length: 450mm
 - Height: 100mm at head of tablet for a length of 150mm tapering to 50mm at foot. Vase(s) may be inset within the head area of the tablet.
 - Inscriptions: to be inscribed on the tapered portion only.
 - Plot Number: to be inscribed on the back of the tablet.
 - Trade Name: the name of the supplier may be displayed on the back of the tablet.
- 8. Each memorial tablet shall be set on the base provided in such a manner that there is an even width of border around the perimeter of the tablet.
- 9. No other item may be placed on or around the space. Any such unauthorised item will be removed and disposed of.
- 10. The planting of shrubs, bulbs etc. is prohibited.
- 11. The Council cannot accept any liability for damage to any tablet through any cause whatsoever, and all memorials are erected at the sole risk and expense of the owner thereof.
- 12. All spaces will be allocated in strict rotation. Selection of a plot cannot be permitted.

Fees payable are as stated in the current scale of fees applicable to the Plymouth City Council.
