The whole of the grave surface will be turfed flat at ground level within a 6 month peri (except for an area designated for a headstone and floral vases if required) and will be maintained to a lawn standard.</li> <li>2. An area of 900mm x 900mm (3' x 3') at the head of the grave may be designated for a memorial and floral vases if required.</li> <li>3. The type of memorials and vases approved for the above area are as follows: <ul> <li>a memorial made of quarried stone not exceeding 900mm (height) on a base not exceed 900mm (width) x 900mm (depth) (3' x 3' x 3')</li> <li>a memorial made of quarried stone not on a base, not exceeding 300mm (height) x 600 (width) x 450mm (depth) (1' x 2' x 1'6")</li> <li>vases to be of quarried stone not exceeding 300mm (height) x 225mm (width) (1' x 9")</li> <li>a memorial tablet made of quarried stone not exceeding 450mm x 225mm (1'6" x 9")</li> <li>the angle of an open book etc should be such that it does not overlap the base.</li> </ul> </li> <li>No other objects to be placed around or on the lawn section of the grave (once turfed for a full list of conditions regarding the use of the cemeteries please contact the appropriate cemetery office.</li> </ul>	od ding Omm
