

Inscription Guide-Box For Arten Memorial Plaques

The guide-box is laid out so that it can be filled with all smaller letters (Black Boxes)
or some larger / capitalised letters for the name (red boxes)
Each box represents a character (including spaces)

In order to ensure that an inscription will fit onto the granite tablet, please note the following information:-

- If you require a further inscription on the tablet, please ensure that enough lines are left for the inscription.
- We will centre the inscription on the tablet, the guide box is only to aid your choice of inscription.
- Do not forget to include spaces in your inscription. One space counts as a character as we can only go so small with the lettering
- The inscription must be clearly written in block capitals.
- We are unable to accept responsibility for any incorrect inscriptions due to illegible or ambiguous writing.
- If you require a design / ornament, please take note this will reduce the amount of lettering space available
